SENATE BILL 1434

AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 41, CHAPTER 32, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTIONS 41-3509 AND 41-3510; RELATING TO INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 41, chapter 32, article 1, Arizona Revised Statutes,
3 is amended by adding sections 41-3509 and 41-3510, to read:

4 41-3509. Consolidation and shared services; transfer of
5 information technology infrastructure; report

6 A. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL IDENTIFY OPPORTUNITIES FOR INFORMATION
7 TECHNOLOGY CONSOLIDATION AND SHARED SERVICES, INCLUDING CONSOLIDATING SERVERS
8 AND DATA CENTERS.

9 B. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT A POLICY THAT ESTABLISHES ALL OF THE
10 FOLLOWING:

11 1. A HARDWARE REFRESH EVALUATION CYCLE FOR BUDGET UNITS THAT REQUIRES
12 EACH BUDGET UNIT TO EVALUATE AND PROGRESSIVELY MIGRATE THE BUDGET UNIT'S
13 INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY INFRASTRUCTURE TO AN OFF-SITE DATA CENTER THAT IS
14 HOSTED AND MANAGED BY A THIRD PARTY. THE POLICY MUST DIRECT BUDGET UNITS TO
15 CONSIDER PURCHASING AND USING COMMERCIAL CLOUD COMPUTING SERVICES BEFORE
16 MAKING ANY NEW INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY OR TELECOMMUNICATIONS INVESTMENT.

17 2. A PLATFORM EVALUATION CYCLE FOR BUDGET UNITS THAT REQUIRES EACH
18 BUDGET UNIT TO EVALUATE AND PROGRESSIVELY MIGRATE THE BUDGET UNIT'S QUALIFIED
19 PLATFORM TO A THIRD-PARTY PLATFORM SERVICE PROVIDER THAT MANAGES AND HOSTS
20 THE PLATFORM. THE POLICY MUST DIRECT BUDGET UNITS TO CONSIDER PURCHASING AND
21 USING COMMERCIAL CLOUD PLATFORM SERVICES BEFORE MAKING ANY NEW PLATFORM
22 INVESTMENT.

23 3. A SOFTWARE EVALUATION CYCLE FOR BUDGET UNITS THAT REQUIRES EACH
24 BUDGET UNIT TO EVALUATE AND PROGRESSIVELY MIGRATE THE BUDGET UNIT'S QUALIFIED
25 SOFTWARE TO A THIRD-PARTY SOFTWARE SERVICE PROVIDER THAT MANAGES AND HOSTS
26 THE SOFTWARE. THE POLICY MUST DIRECT BUDGET UNITS TO CONSIDER PURCHASING AND
27 USING COMMERCIAL CLOUD SOFTWARE SERVICES BEFORE MAKING ANY NEW SOFTWARE
28 INVESTMENT.

29 C. ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2017, EACH BUDGET UNIT SHALL REPORT TO THE
30 DEPARTMENT REGARDING THE BUDGET UNIT'S PLAN FOR MIGRATING THE BUDGET UNIT'S
31 INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY INFRASTRUCTURE FROM AN ON-PREMISES TO AN OFF-SITE DATA
32 CENTER THAT IS HOSTED AND MANAGED BY A THIRD PARTY.

33 D. BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2017, EACH BUDGET UNIT SHALL REPORT TO THE
34 DEPARTMENT, THE CHIEF INFORMATION OFFICER AND THE CHAIRPERSON OF THE JOINT
35 LEGISLATIVE BUDGET COMMITTEE ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1 AND JULY 1 OF EACH YEAR
36 ON THE BUDGET UNIT'S PROGRESS IN TRANSFERRING DATA PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION B
37 OF THIS SECTION AND ANY FACTORS DELAYING OR INHIBITING THE EXPANSION OF CLOUD
38 COMPUTING USAGE.

39 41-3510. Information technology infrastructure plan; joint
40 legislative budget committee approval

41 A BUDGET UNIT SHALL SUBMIT EACH INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY INFRASTRUCTURE
42 PLAN TO THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE BUDGET COMMITTEE FOR APPROVAL BEFORE AWARDED
43 ANY CONTRACT FOR INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY INFRASTRUCTURE. THE JOINT
44 LEGISLATIVE BUDGET COMMITTEE MAY MEET IN EXECUTIVE SESSION TO CONSIDER THE
45 PLAN. THE PLAN SHALL INCLUDE ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

- 1 1. A PROJECT INVESTMENT JUSTIFICATION OR REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL.
- 2 2. THE NAME OF EACH BIDDER THAT WAS REQUESTED TO BID, AND EACH BIDDER
- 3 THAT SUBMITTED A BID FOR THE PROJECT AND THE AMOUNTS AND CONDITIONS OF THE
- 4 BIDS.
- 5 3. THE NAME AND BID AMOUNT OF THE PROPOSED SUCCESSFUL BIDDER.
