Re: HB 2030: liquor premises; firearms; retired officers

Date: April 21, 2016

AS PASSED THE HOUSE

HB 2030 clarifies that a retired peace officer or an honorably retired law enforcement officer who meets specific criteria may possess a firearm while in a licensed establishment that sells, serves or furnishes liquor.

SENATE AMENDMENTS

The Senate amended HB 2030 to make a conforming change.

CONFERENCE COMMITTEE REPORT (AMENDMENT)

The Free Conference Committee amended HB 2030 as follows:

- Allows the Director of the Arizona Department of Liquor Licenses and Control to issue a temporary permit of any series to a trustee in bankruptcy that acquires the spirituous liquor of a debtor, for the purpose of disposing of the liquor at a public auction as outlined in statute.
- Makes conforming changes.
