CONCUR-REFUSE BLUE SHEET #4

[HB 2084](#) passed the Senate on March 16, 2016 ([28-0-2-0-0](#)) and is listed on **Blue Sheet #4**.

AS PASSED THE HOUSE

HB 2084 requires the Arizona Department of Health Services (DHS) to annually provide the Secretary of State (SOS) with access to the statewide system of death records for comparison against the Statewide Voter Registration Database.

SENATE AMENDMENTS

The Senate amended HB 2084 as follows:

1. Requires DHS to transmit monthly to the SOS the death records of *every* state resident, rather than residents age 16 years and older.
2. Stipulates the records may only include the decedent's:
 - a) name;
 - b) date of birth;
 - c) social security number, if available;
 - d) usual legal residence at the time of death; and
 - e) father's or mother's name, if available.
3. Directs DHS to annually provide the SOS with a record of all deaths from the statewide electronic death registration system, rather than providing *access* to the system.
4. Makes technical changes.
