OVERVIEW

HB 2248 requires an autocycle to be fully or partially enclosed, rather than completely enclosed, and states that a Class D license is valid for operating an autocycle.

PROVISIONS

1. Modifies the definition of an *autocycle* to include three-wheeled motorcycles that are fully or partially enclosed, rather than completely enclosed.
2. Stipulates that a Class D license is valid for operating an autocycle.
3. Makes technical changes.

CURRENT LAW

Currently, statute defines an *autocycle* as a three-wheeled motorcycle on which the driver and passengers ride in a completely enclosed seating area that is equipped with a roll cage, safety belts, antilock brakes and that is designed to be controlled with a steering wheel and pedals ([A.R.S. § 28-101](#)).
