MEDIA ADVISORY: Rep. Paul Boyer to Detail Legislation Meant to Stop Internet Crimes against Children

STATE CAPITOL, PHOENIX (February 9, 2015) – Rep. Paul Boyer is leading an effort to propose "[Alicia's Law](#)" in Arizona, giving a much-needed financial boost to Arizona's Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) task force. The task force is currently overwhelmed by a sharp increase in reports of online child pornography trading.

At **9:30 a.m., Tuesday Feb. 10**, Boyer will be on the **House lawn** to discuss the solution he has proposed, which would dedicate a stream of revenue to Arizona's ICAC task force. He will be joined by **Alicia Kozakiewicz**, a victim and namesake of the Alicia's Law campaign by the [National Association to Protect Children](#).
