Representative Carter Applauds House Passage of Legislation Creating Overdose Review Team

STATE CAPITOL, PHOENIX – The House of Representatives yesterday voted to pass <u>HB</u> <u>2493</u>, legislation sponsored by Representative Heather Carter (R-15) that establishes a 21-member team within Arizona Department of Health Services to combat the growing opioid crisis.

The team will develop a system to track drug overdose fatalities and conduct annual analysis on the causes and incidents of overdose fatalities in the preceding fiscal year.

"There must be a system in place to track the growing opioid crisis within the state," said Representative Carter. "Once this system is in place, we will be able to effectively battle the growing epidemic to save lives."
