Rep. Maria Syms: Throat Punch Comment Makes Rep. Rubalcava Unfit for Office

STATE CAPITOL, PHOENIX – Representative Maria Syms (R-28) today released the following statement regarding a violent comment made by Representative Jesus Rubalcava (D-4).

Responding to a comment about Senator Debbie Lesko (R-21) on Facebook, Representative Rubalcava said, "I wanted to punch her in the throat!"

"It takes a small man to fantasize about violence against women on social media, and nothing less than zero tolerance is acceptable," said Representative Syms. "This is not the kind of behavior toward women we should expect as a society from a man or a father, much less a school board member or an elected Representative. This issue transcends politics or party."

"Every person in this body should stand against such statements. We have made great strides in our legislature – just this session passing the rape kit bill and the sexual assault counselor bill, and soon a victims' rights bill. This violent statement sets us all back as a representative body and as a state."

"I have this to say to Mr. Rubalcava – for myself and all the women and victims of violence: apology not accepted. Mr. Rubalcava is showing himself unfit for public office."
