## Rep. Mark Finchem Reacts to Latest Allegations of Improper Ballot Signature Gathering

**STATE CAPITOL, PHOENIX** – Representative Mark Finchem (R-11) today released the following statement in reaction to the latest allegations that Save Our Schools petition gatherers improperly circulated petitions for a referendum on SB 1431.

"The folks behind the petition drive to limit parental choice in education will stop at nothing to disrupt Empowerment Scholarship Accounts," said Representative Finchem. "Given the wide range of impropriety of signature collections, it is clear that the government education monopoly doesn't care about complying with state law."

SB 1431 expands parental choice by way of the Empowerment Scholarship Account program and adds more fiscal responsibility, academic accountability, and transparency to the program. Mr. Finchem wholeheartedly supported this legislation.

"I am distressed by the number of statutory compliant irregularities," added Representative Finchem. "Strict compliance was intended to prevent this type of unacceptable behavior."
