House of Representatives Retains Outside Counsel to Investigate Sexual Harassment Allegations

STATE CAPITOL, PHOENIX – The Arizona House of Representatives today retained Craig Morgan of the law firm Sherman & Howard to investigate sexual harassment allegations at the Legislature.
