UNANIMOUS CONSENT CALENDAR

Monday, February 23, 2026, 9:12 AM

Senate Rules provide for the use of a Unanimous Consent Calendar to bypass Committee of the Whole and move unamended bills to Third Reading in order to expedite the legislative process.

Members may protest any bill being so advanced by submitting the protest in writing to the Secretary of the Senate during the **48 hour** posting period. Any protest will automatically remove the bill from the Consent Calendar, and all remaining bills will be placed on the Third Reading Calendar.

Protest must be filed no later than:

Wednesday, February 25, 2026, 9:12 AM
