Third Read CONSENT CALENDAR #11

Monday, March 30, 2026, 2:00 p.m.

House Rules provide for the use of a Third Read Consent Calendar to bypass Committee of the Whole and move unamended bills to Third Reading in order to expedite the legislative process.

Pursuant to House Rule 11(E), Members may remove their consent for any bill being so advanced by submitting a Consent Removal Form in writing to the Office of the Chief Clerk during the two-day posting period. This form will automatically remove the bill from the Third Read Consent Calendar. All remaining bills are available for placement on a Third Reading Calendar.
