In accordance with Senate Rule 26(A), any person desiring to be heard concerning legislation remotely shall email that request to (SenateTAT@azleg.gov) by 9 P.M. the day prior to committee, excluding weekends and holidays. Timely requests will receive a response that includes meeting access information to participate in the committee remotely. Sharing meeting access information with unauthorized users may result in being prohibited to participate remotely in future legislative hearings. The request to participate remotely via teleconference shall be in addition to requesting to speak via the RTS system (<https://apps.azleg.gov/RequestToSpeak/AgendaSearch>). Persons desiring to testify remotely shall indicate that the participation is remote within the comments of the RTS system.

Public testimony is limited to remote participation.
