**HCM 2003: urging EPA; Congress; nuclear power**

Urges Congress and the EPA to recognize nuclear power as a viable source of clean energy and commend Arizona's diversified energy portfolio.

**HCM 2005/SCM 1005: hardrock mining; rule; urging EPA**

Urges the EPA to withdraw the proposed rule regarding new financial assurance requirements on the hardrock mining industry and start over with the objective of deferring regulation to existing state and federal programs.

**HCM 2006: clean power plan; repeal; replace**

Urges the EPA to repeal the Clean Power Plan and work with states to develop a reasonable replacement program acceptable to all parties concerned with coal-fired electricity generation.

**HCM 2008: exceptional events rule; revisions**

Urges the EPA to revise the Exceptional Events Rule to provide for an effective process to address background ozone and other emissions that are outside of the state's regulatory control.

Urges Congress to formally recognize February 6th as the Day of Zero Tolerance for Female Genital Mutilation.

**HCR 2010/SCR 1024: application; Article V convention**

Urges Congress to call an Article V Convention of the States limited to proposing amendments to the U.S. Constitution that impose fiscal restraints on the federal government, limit the power and jurisdiction of the federal government and limit the terms of office for its officials and members of Congress.

**HCR 2013: convention; balanced federal budget**

Urges Congress to call a Convention of the States to propose an amendment to the U.S. Constitution that limits total federal appropriations for any FY not to exceed the total estimated federal revenue for that FY.

**HCR 2022: balanced budget convention; delegates**

Outlines the selection of, and instructions for, Arizona's delegation to attend an Article V Convention. Calls for a planning Convention to convene in Phoenix, Arizona at 12:00 p.m. on September 12, 2017, for the limited purposes of planning for, and recommending rules and procedures to, the prospective convention for proposing a balanced budget amendment to the U.S. Constitution.

**HCR 2025: hidden heroes' day; military caregivers**

Designates May 20, 2017, as Hidden Heroes Day along with Military Appreciation Month and urges the Legislature to support its residents who serve in vital military and veteran caregiving roles.

**HJR 2002/SJR 1003: lower Colorado basin; forbearance authority.**

Authorizes the ADWR Director to enter into an agreement to forbear Arizona's right to certain quantities of intentionally created surplus from the Colorado River that would otherwise be available for use in Arizona under certain conditions. Requires the ADWR Director to promptly notify the Legislature on any agreement entered into and revokes the authority to enter into an agreement on December 31, 2017.

Urges Congress to amend the Wild and Scenic Rivers Act to require congressional, state, county and local approval before a river may be designated as wild, scenic or recreational.

Excludes, upon voter approval, certain adjustments to CORP provided in Senate Bill 1442 as enacted by the 53rd Legislature, First Regular Session from the constitutional prohibition of diminishment or impairment of benefits.

Requires the Secretary of State to submit the proposition to the voters at the next general election.
