HB 2406 (Chapter 19): state treasurer; financial services

Stipulates which types of services the Arizona State Treasurer's Office is required to contract for on behalf of state agencies and which types of financial services require the Treasurer's permission in order to be contracted for by state agencies.

Appropriates \$102,261.81 from the state GF and \$43,587.72 from other funds in FY 2020 for the payment of claims against state agencies.

SB 1224 (Chapter 12): NOW: empowerment scholarships; qualifications; administration; appropriations

Directs the State Board of Education (SBE), rather than the Arizona Department of Education (ADE), to adopt rules and policies necessary to administer Arizona Empowerment Scholarships (ESAs). Modifies the definition of *qualified school*. Appropriates a total of \$1,100,000 and 14 full-time employees from the state General Fund to SBE and ADE for ESA program administration.
