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**HB 2398 (Chapter 82): appropriations; named claimants**

Makes supplemental appropriations totaling \$191,596.85 from certain funds for the payment of claims.

Makes numerous changes related to theme park districts and theme park district governing boards of directors.

**SB 1078 (Chapter 442): medical student loan program**

Continues the Board of Medical Student Loans for 8 years, until July 1, 2029, retroactive to July 1, 2021. Modifies penalties for liquidated damages for loan recipients who fail to fulfill conditions of a contract.

Establishes procedures and requirements for the voluntary certification of doulas.

**SB 1462/HB 2406 (Chapter 18): appropriation; child care services**

Makes a supplemental \$92,712,300 appropriation from the Child Care Development Fund Block Grant to the Arizona Department of Economic Security for child care services.

**SB 1752 (Chapter 232): NOW: conformity; internal revenue code**

Conforms Arizona's income tax calculation for taxable years beginning January 1, 2021 to the changes made to the Internal Revenue Code (IRC), as amended and in effect on March 11, 2021 with the specific adoption of all retroactive effective dates but excluding all changes to the IRC enacted after March 11, 2021.
