Declares that the Members of the Arizona House of Representatives: 1) support the negotiation of a United States-Taiwan bilateral trade agreement and Taiwan's participation in international organizations; 2) acknowledge the achievements made by Arizona and Taiwan in trade, technology, education, culture and economy since establishing their sister-state relations on July 28, 1980 and encourage continued bilateral cooperation; and 3) support a future official visit to Taiwan by the Governor of Arizona at his discretion.

**SCM 1002: higher education grants; Indian education**

States the Legislature prays the United States Congress take affirmative steps to forward fund the Higher Education Grant Program of the Bureau of Indian Education.

Amends the Arizona Constitution, subject to voter approval, to repeal sections relating to property tax exemptions and replaces the sections with a consolidated property tax exemption section.

**SCR 1012: NOW: voter identification; affidavit; procedure**

Requires early voters to return the ballot, the copy of the voters early voter identification and the completed affidavit. Prohibits ADOT from charging a fee for issuing a non-operating identification license, if the

applicant attests that the application for such license is in order to comply with legal requirements for registering to vote or voting.

**SCR 1016: death resolution; Representative Frank Pratt**

Adds, subject to voter approval, the lieutenant governor position to the Arizona Executive Department. Outlines the requirements for the joint ticket for the office of the governor and lieutenant governor and details the order of succession. Applies to elections for the term of office that begins in 2027.

**SCR 1049: fire districts; funding; TPT increment**

Subject to voter approval, establishes the Fire District Safety Fund (FDSF) and applies an additional 0.1% transaction privilege tax and use tax for the next 20 years to provision the FDSF. The FDSF's monies are to be administered by the State Treasurer and distributed to fire districts in Arizona.
