SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 1004

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA; AMENDING ARTICLE IX,
CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA, BY ADDING SECTION 26; RELATING TO TAXATION.

1 Be it resolved by the Senate of the State of Arizona, the House of
2 Representatives concurring:

3 1. Article IX, Constitution of Arizona, is proposed to be amended by
4 adding section 26 as follows if approved by the voters and on proclamation
5 of the Governor:

6 26. Vehicle miles traveled; taxing, monitoring and
7 limiting prohibited; exception

8 SECTION 26. A. THIS STATE AND ANY COUNTY, CITY, TOWN,
9 MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OR OTHER POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THIS
10 STATE MAY NOT DO EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING:

11 1. IMPOSE A TAX OR FEE ON ANY PERSON BASED ON THE VEHICLE
12 MILES TRAVELED BY THE PERSON IN A MOTOR VEHICLE.

13 2. ENACT ANY RULE OR LAW TO MONITOR OR LIMIT THE VEHICLE
14 MILES TRAVELED BY A PERSON IN A MOTOR VEHICLE UNLESS THE RULE
15 OR LAW REQUIRES THAT THE PERSON VOLUNTARILY CONSENTS TO THE
16 MONITORING OR LIMITATION.

17 B. THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING:

18 1. AN INTERSTATE AGREEMENT THAT IS ESTABLISHED TO
19 ADMINISTER THE PAYMENT OR REPORTING OF FUEL TAXES OR REGISTRATION
20 FEES FOR COMMERCIAL VEHICLES THAT OPERATE IN MORE THAN ONE STATE.

21 2. A MOTOR VEHICLE OWNED AND OPERATED BY ANY ENTITY LISTED
22 IN SUBSECTION A OF THIS SECTION.

23 2. The Secretary of State shall submit this proposition to the voters
24 at the next general election as provided by article XXI, Constitution of
25 Arizona.
