

Advisory Committee on the Formation of a Southern Arizona Regional Sports Authority

PURPOSE: To research and report on the economic development and fiscal and related impacts of the formation of a southern Arizona regional sports authority. On or before June 30, 2022, the Committee shall submit a report of its findings and recommendations to the Governor, the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives and provide a copy of this report to the Secretary of State.
