

Arizona Off-Highway Vehicle Study Committee

PURPOSE: The Committee shall collect and study information from the public and stakeholders regarding off-highway vehicle issues in this State. On or before January 1 of each year, they shall submit a report regarding the Committee's activities and recommendations for administrative or legislative action to the Governor, the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives and provide a copy of this report to the Secretary of State.
