

Assessment Advisory Committee

PURPOSE: To review definitions and guidelines pertaining to the status of property as real or personal property and secured or unsecured property and to review residual value percentages assigned by the Department of Revenue to various types of personal property. The Committee may recommend to the Department changes that it believes will increase statewide uniformity in determining property status, and changes in percentages that it believes will more accurately reflect residual market value of personal property.

Notes: The Committee shall meet at least annually at the call of the Director of the Department of Revenue. Select members are eligible for reimbursement of expenses.
