

House Ad Hoc Committee on International Affairs

PURPOSE: The committee shall review opportunities for Arizona to grow its international presence and stature, build relationships with international partners, enhance trade and foreign investment, and strengthen border security. The committee shall be responsible for organizing visits of international dignitaries to Arizona and to organize joint events with those dignitaries. The committee shall identify and work with outside organizations to strengthen Arizona's relationships. Finally, the committee shall hold hearings related to foreign trade, international affairs, and border security.

House Eight members of the House of Representatives, not more than four from the same political party, with two appointed as co-chairs, appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives.
