

House Ad Hoc Committee on Oversight, Accountability and Big Tech

PURPOSE: To: (1) learn about emerging legal and constitutional issues surrounding censorship by government officials and social media interference, big tech manipulation of internet platforms, and the use of artificial intelligence; (2) identify, evaluate, and develop recommendations to the Arizona House of Representatives for potential legislation to address these issues; and (3) engage in investigations related to these topics to exercise legislative oversight, including election-related oversight, of government entities and elected officials.
