

# Joint Ad Hoc Committee on County Boundaries

**PURPOSE:** To research and report on the fiscal and related impacts of a change in the county boundary line between Cochise County and Santa Cruz County and other areas. The committee shall submit a report of its findings and recommendations to the Governor, the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives on or before December 31, 2020 and provide a copy of the report to the Secretary of State.
