

# Joint Legislative Ad-Hoc on Statewide Juvenile Justice

**PURPOSE:** To study and review: (1) Juvenile Justice in Arizona, to include a look at the ADJC secure care facility at Adobe Mountain; (2) the state's needs and best options to rehabilitate the youths in custody, ensuring that every kid gets the programming and education they need to turn their lives around and become successful members of society; (3) study trends and future projections to better understand the future needs of the State and counties; (4) the current status of the Adobe Mountain Facility and composition of youths at the facility and options for the future of the entire facility; (5) the potential future options for youths currently housed at the Adobe Mountain facility; (6) an overview of the Department of Juvenile Correction's funding mechanism and the relationship between counties and the State of Arizona in regard to juvenile corrections; and (7) the usage of State land following any adjustments made to the Adobe Mountain facility.
