

Joint Legislative Psychiatric Hospital Review Council

PURPOSE: To review, analyze and make recommendations regarding at least the following: 1) psychiatric hospital capacity in this state, including the bed capacity at the Arizona State Hospital and other public facilities; 2) the role of private facilities in addressing psychiatric treatment needs; 3) innovative programs to ensure public safety while providing clinically appropriate treatment in the most integrated setting; 4) legal barriers; 5) current waiting lists; 6) barriers to accessing appropriate inpatient care; 7) licensing barriers; 8) any other issues related to inpatient psychiatric treatment and 9) the feasibility of transferring the Arizona State Hospital to the Arizona Health Care Cost Containment System or an alternative oversight entity. On or before December 31, 2022 and December 31, 2023, the Review Council shall submit a report of its findings and recommendations to the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the President of the Senate and the Governor and shall provide a copy of the reports to the Secretary of State.
