

Senate Ad Hoc Committee on Elder Abuse

PURPOSE: To collect and evaluate expert and public testimony on the prevalence and impact on elder abuse, including physical, emotional, financial, and systemic exploitation, with specific attention to alleged misconduct within court-appointed systems such as guardian and litems, in order to identify gaps in existing laws and oversight and develop informed legislative solutions that strengthen accountability and protect vulnerable adults.
