

Study Committee on Private Land Acquisition

PURPOSE: To: (1) conduct hearings and collect and analyze information relating to the acquisition of privately owned real property by government entities; (2) examine the impact that ownership of real property by a government entity has on the economies of this State and of local communities; (3) identify a process to allow a government entity to acquire privately owned real property without reducing the tax base of the local community. The Committee shall submit a report regarding its activities, findings and recommendations to the Governor, the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives on or before December 31, 2019 and provide a copy of this report to the Secretary of State.
