

Study Committee on Private Land Acquisition

PURPOSE: To: (1) conduct hearings and collect and analyze information relating to the acquisition of privately owned real property by government entities; (2) examine the impact that ownership of real property by a government entity has on the economies of this State and of local communities; (3) identify a process to allow a government entity to acquire privately owned real property without reducing the tax base of the local community. The Committee shall submit a report regarding its activities, findings and recommendations to the Governor, the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives on or before December 31, 2017.
