Notes: No more than three of the Governor's appointees may be from the same political party. No member of the Board may simultaneously hold any State or local elective public office. The Governor, the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall make appointments to produce a general geographically diverse representation of areas in the Authority. Members of the Board shall be appointed for five-year terms with the exception of initial terms which shall be three, four, and five year terms as determined by lot. A member may be re-appointed for one full subsequent term. Members of the Board are eligible for compensation.
