Senator Klein moved the School Safety Program Oversight Committee ADOPT the requirements of SB 1185 into the Guidance Manual. Ms. Larsen seconded the motion. The motion CARRIED by voice vote.

Consideration of Arizona Foundation for Legal Services and Education Contract

Joannie Collins, Arizona Foundation for Legal Services and Education, discussed the contract (Attachment A) for the Arizona Foundation for Legal Services and Education and the services provided.

Senator Klein moved the School Safety Program Oversight Committee approve the renewal of the Arizona Foundation for Legal Services and Education FY 2013 contract. Ms. Larsen seconded the motion. The motion CARRIED by voice vote.
