ACJC Main Program Areas

- **Criminal Justice Systems Improvement**
- **Crime Victim Services**
- **Drug, Gang & Violent Crime**
- **Statistical Analysis Center**

ACJC Budget Issues

- **Information & Technology Integration and Improvements**
 - Dramatic need for a multi-year, system-wide improvement of information and data sharing capabilities which are vital to public safety in Arizona.
- **State Aid to Indigent Defense – Fill the Gap**
 - Since FY 2012 all revenue from this fund has been redirected to DPS
 - This does not meet the statutory purpose of the fund's creation which is to “improve case processing.”

Declining CJEF Revenues

- **Declining revenues in the CJEF are having a major impact on criminal justice activities in Arizona.**
 - **17% decline over the past six fiscal years (\$43.7 Million to \$36.4 Million)**
 - **AZ POST and APAAC fully funded by CJEF**
 - **Both organizations are cutting training activities for their members**
