# **SENATE BILL 1065**

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTIONS 41-862 AND 41-1352, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO THE ARIZONA HISTORICAL ADVISORY COMMISSION.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:  
2       Section 1. Section 41-862, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
3 read:

4           41-862. Program

5       In cooperation with the state historic preservation officer, each state  
6 agency shall establish a program to locate, inventory and nominate to the  
7 Arizona register of historic places all properties **THAT ARE** under the  
8 agency's ownership or control **AND** that appear to meet the criteria for  
9 inclusion on the register. Each state agency shall exercise caution to  
10 assure that the property is not inadvertently transferred, sold, demolished,  
11 substantially altered or allowed to deteriorate significantly. The **Arizona**  
**historical advisory commission** **STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICER** shall  
12 include the performance of state agencies in initiating and satisfying the  
13 programmatic management of historic properties in **its THE** annual report to  
14 the legislature and the governor as provided in section 41-1352.

15       Sec. 2. Section 41-1352, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

16           41-1352. Historical advisory commission; membership; terms;  
17                   expenses; duties; historic sites review committee

18       A. A historical advisory commission is established consisting of  
19 members appointed by the director for staggered terms of three years ending  
20 on July 1. The commission membership of not less than ten nor more than  
21 twenty members shall consist of experts **in the field of historic preservation**  
22 in the disciplines of history, **ARTS AND CULTURE**, architecture and  
23 archaeology, professional librarians and archivists or persons otherwise  
24 associated with the interpretation, research, writing, preservation or  
25 teaching of this state's heritage, **INCLUDING THE INDIAN NATIONS' HISTORY AND**  
26 **HERITAGE**, and the director of the **ARIZONA** historical society, the director of  
27 the state museum, the director of the **ARIZONA** state parks board and the state  
28 historic preservation officer.

29       B. Members shall serve without compensation but those employed by the  
30 state shall be reimbursed for travel and subsistence by the department or  
31 agency they represent.

32           C. The commission shall:

33           1. Advise the legislature and state agencies on matters relating to  
34 **THIS STATE'S HISTORY AND** historic preservation.

35           2. Recommend measures to the legislature and state agencies to  
36 coordinate or improve the effectiveness of activities of state agencies and  
37 agencies of the political subdivisions of this state and other persons  
38 relating to **THE INTERPRETATION, RESEARCH, WRITING AND TEACHING OF THIS**  
39 **STATE'S HISTORY, HERITAGE AND** historic preservation, **INCLUDING THE INDIAN**  
40 **NATIONS' HISTORY, HERITAGE AND PRESERVATION.**

41           3. Advise the legislature and state agencies on the dissemination of  
42 information pertaining to activities relating to historic preservation as  
43 provided in paragraph 2 **of this subsection.**

44           4. Encourage, in cooperation with appropriate public and private  
45 agencies, **THE INDIAN NATIONS** and other persons, training and education in the

1 field of THE INTERPRETATION, RESEARCH, WRITING AND TEACHING OF THIS STATE'S  
2 HISTORY, HERITAGE AND historic preservation.

3       5. Submit annually on September 30 a report OF THE COMMISSION'S  
4 ACTIVITIES to the DIRECTOR FOR INCLUSION IN THE ANNUAL REPORT OF THE STATE  
5 LIBRARY. ~~governor and the legislature. The report shall include the~~  
~~historical advisory commission's activities and the performance of state~~  
~~agencies in their historic preservation activities pursuant to chapter 4.2 of~~  
~~this title.~~

6       D. A historic sites review committee consisting of nine members is  
7 established to serve as a standing committee of the historical advisory  
8 commission. The state historic preservation officer shall appoint committee  
9 members for staggered terms of three years ending on July 1. The state  
10 historic preservation officer may appoint persons other than commission  
11 members to serve on the committee and shall appoint at least five persons who  
12 are professionals qualified in the disciplines of history, prehistoric and  
13 historic archaeology, architectural history or architecture. The committee  
14 shall select annually at the first meeting a chairman who is a commission  
15 member. The chairman shall report on committee activities at commission  
16 meetings. The committee shall assist in the duties prescribed in this  
17 section and by federal law, review nominations to the national and state  
18 historic registers, provide general advice and guidance to the state historic  
19 preservation officer and perform other duties as are necessary. ON OR BEFORE  
20 SEPTEMBER 1 OF EACH YEAR, THE STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICER SHALL  
21 SUBMIT A REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE'S ACTIVITIES TO THE GOVERNOR, THE PRESIDENT  
22 OF THE SENATE, THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE DIRECTOR,  
23 INCLUDING INFORMATION PRESCRIBED IN SECTIONS 41-862 AND 41-881.

24       Sec. 3. Arizona centennial 2012

25       A. The historical advisory commission shall develop and coordinate a  
26 statewide plan regarding this state's centennial in 2012. The plan shall  
27 include the following:

28           1. Advising the legislature and state agencies on centennial history  
29 and heritage, arts and culture and related activities.

30           2. Assisting the governor's countdown to the centennial to support  
31 school children learning about this state's history.

32           3. Recommending activities and projects that will ensure lasting  
33 legacy accomplishments to commemorate the centennial.

34       B. Pursuant to section 41-1336, Arizona Revised Statutes, the director  
35 of the Arizona state library, archives and public records may accept and  
36 spend public and private appropriations, grants, gifts, contributions and  
37 devises to assist in carrying out this section.

38       Sec. 4. Delayed repeal

39       Section 3 of this act, relating to Arizona centennial 2012, is repealed  
40 from and after August 31, 2014.
