AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 44, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING CHAPTER 35; RELATING
TO SERVICE STATIONS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Title 44, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended by adding
3 chapter 35, to read:

4 CHAPTER 35

5 SERVICE STATIONS

6 ARTICLE 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

7 44-7801. Making available to customers water, compressed air
8 and an air pressure gauge; civil penalty; definition

9 A. BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2009, DURING OPERATING HOURS, EVERY SERVICE
10 STATION IN THIS STATE SHALL MAKE AVAILABLE, AT NO COST TO CUSTOMERS WHO
11 PURCHASE MOTOR VEHICLE FUEL, WATER, COMPRESSED AIR AND A GAUGE FOR MEASURING
12 AIR PRESSURE FOR USE IN SERVICING ANY PASSENGER VEHICLE OR ANY COMMERCIAL
13 VEHICLE OF LESS THAN SIX THOUSAND POUNDS UNLADEN WEIGHT.

14 B. EVERY SERVICE STATION IN THIS STATE SHALL DISPLAY AT A CONSPICUOUS
15 PLACE ON, AT OR NEAR THE DISPENSING APPARATUS AT LEAST ONE CLEARLY VISIBLE
16 SIGN THAT READS AS FOLLOWS:

17 ARIZONA LAW REQUIRES THIS STATION TO PROVIDE FREE AIR AND
18 WATER FOR AUTOMOTIVE PURPOSES TO ITS CUSTOMERS WHO PURCHASE
19 MOTOR VEHICLE FUEL. IF YOU HAVE A COMPLAINT, NOTIFY THE STATION
20 ATTENDANT OR CONTACT THE DEPARTMENT OF WEIGHTS AND MEASURES.

21 C. ANY PERSON WHO INTENTIONALLY VIOLATES THIS CHAPTER IS SUBJECT TO A
22 CIVIL PENALTY OF NOT TO EXCEED FIFTY DOLLARS FOR EACH DAY THAT THE PERSON IS
23 IN VIOLATION OF THIS CHAPTER.

24 D. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "SERVICE STATION" MEANS A PLACE
25 OPERATED PRIMARILY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DELIVERING MOTOR VEHICLE FUEL INTO THE
26 FUEL TANKS OF MOTOR VEHICLES AS DEFINED IN SECTION 28-101.
