AN ACT

PROVIDING FOR THE SALE OF CERTAIN STATE PROPERTIES.

(TEXT OF BILL BEGINS ON NEXT PAGE)

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Sale of certain state properties; review; deposit of  
3 monies

4 A. The department of administration shall sell to the highest and best  
5 bidder at a public auction held for that purpose the state property located  
6 at 2422 W. Holly, Phoenix, Arizona, including the two trailers that are  
7 located on that property. The sale shall include the buildings and  
8 appurtenant land, personal property and other improvements required for the  
9 operation of the property or the Arizona department of agriculture  
10 laboratory. The property is subject to two current independent appraisals  
11 and an independent title search before the property is offered for sale.

12 B. Sale of the property shall begin as soon as possible after the  
13 effective date of this act and shall be completed before July 1, 2010.

14 C. The sale is subject to review by the joint committee on capital  
15 review.

16 D. All proceeds of the sale shall be deposited, pursuant to sections  
17 35-146 and 35-147, Arizona Revised Statutes, in the state general fund.

18 Sec. 2. Sale of certain state aircraft; review; deposit of  
19 monies

20 A. The department of public safety shall sell to the highest and best  
21 bidder at a public auction held for that purpose one of the twin engine  
22 airplanes and one of the helicopters purchased by the department pursuant to  
23 section 41-1834, Arizona Revised Statutes. The director of the department of  
24 public safety shall select which airplane and helicopter will be sold  
25 pursuant to this subsection. All property is subject to two current  
26 independent appraisals before the property is offered for sale.

27 B. Sale of the properties shall begin as soon as possible after the  
28 effective date of this act and shall be completed before July 1, 2010.

29 C. Each sale is subject to review by the joint committee on capital  
30 review.

31 D. Notwithstanding section 41-1752, Arizona Revised Statutes, all  
32 proceeds of the sales shall be deposited, pursuant to sections 35-146 and  
33 35-147, Arizona Revised Statutes, in the state general fund.
