SENATE BILL 1027

AN ACT

AUTHORIZING A PILOT PROGRAM TO USE SEISMIC SENSORS TO MONITOR ILLEGAL
ACTIVITY.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Immigration; seismic sensors; grants; pilot program;
3 report; delayed repeal

4 A. The department of public safety shall seek grants to implement a
5 one-year pilot program that would use seismic sensors to monitor rural
6 airport runways and other rural areas of this state where illegal drug
7 traffic and illegal alien traffic or human smuggling are likely to occur.

8 B. If the grant allows for reimbursement of application expenses, the
9 department shall include on the grant application a request for a
10 reimbursement of all costs related to the application process.

11 C. On or before July 1, 2012, the department of public safety shall
12 submit a report regarding the effectiveness of the pilot program to the
13 governor, the speaker of the house of representatives and the president of
14 the senate and shall provide a copy of this report to the secretary of state.

15 D. This section is repealed from and after December 31, 2012.
