A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA; REPEALING ARTICLE II, SECTION 31, CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA; REPEALING ARTICLE XVIII, SECTION 6, CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA; RELATING TO DAMAGES FOR INJURIES.

1 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Arizona, the
2 Senate concurring:

3 1. Article II, section 31, Constitution of Arizona, is proposed to be
4 repealed as follows if approved by the voters and on proclamation of the
5 Governor:

6 Article II, section 31, Constitution of Arizona, relating
7 to damages for death or personal injuries, is repealed.

8 2. Article XVIII, section 6, Constitution of Arizona, is proposed to
9 be repealed as follows if approved by the voters and on proclamation of the
10 Governor:

11 Article XVIII, section 6, Constitution of Arizona,
12 relating to the recovery of damages for injuries, is repealed.

13 3. The Secretary of State shall submit this proposition to the voters
14 at the next general election as provided by article XXI, Constitution of
15 Arizona.
