AN ACT

REPEALING SECTIONS 28-1202, 28-1203, 28-1204 AND 28-1205, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; AMENDING TITLE 28, CHAPTER 3, ARTICLE 21, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING A NEW SECTION 28-1202; REPEALING SECTION 28-1602, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO PHOTO ENFORCEMENT.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Repeal

3 Sections 28-1202, 28-1203, 28-1204 and 28-1205, Arizona Revised  
4 Statutes, are repealed.

5 Sec. 2. Title 28, chapter 3, article 21, Arizona Revised Statutes, is  
6 amended by adding a new section 28-1202, to read:

7 28-1202. Photo enforcement system; prohibition

8 A PHOTO ENFORCEMENT SYSTEM SHALL NOT BE USED BY A LOCAL AUTHORITY OR  
9 ANY AGENCY OF THIS STATE TO IDENTIFY VIOLATORS OF ARTICLE 3 OR 6 OF THIS  
10 CHAPTER.

11 Sec. 3. Repeal

12 Section 28-1602, Arizona Revised Statutes, is repealed.
