AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 36, CHAPTER 28.1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 36-2820; RELATING TO MEDICAL MARIJUANA.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Pursuant to article IV, part 1, section 1, Constitution of
3 Arizona, title 36, chapter 28.1, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended by
4 adding section 36-2820, to read:

5 36-2820. Advertising and labeling inconsistent with this
6 chapter; prohibition; certification revocation

7 THE DEPARTMENT SHALL IMMEDIATELY REVOKE THE REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE OF
8 A REGISTERED NONPROFIT MEDICAL MARIJUANA DISPENSARY THAT EITHER:

9 1. DISPENSES MEDICAL MARIJUANA THAT IS PACKAGED IN A WAY THAT STATES,
10 SUGGESTS OR IMPLIES THAT ITS USE IS FOR ANYTHING OTHER THAN THE MEDICINAL
11 PURPOSES PRESCRIBED BY THIS CHAPTER.

12 2. ADVERTISES IN A WAY THAT STATES, SUGGESTS OR IMPLIES THAT IT
13 DISPENSES MEDICAL MARIJUANA FOR A USE OTHER THAN THE MEDICINAL PURPOSES
14 PRESCRIBED BY THIS CHAPTER.

15 Sec. 2. Requirements for enactment; three-fourths vote

16 Pursuant to article IV, part 1, section 1, Constitution of Arizona,
17 section 36-2920, Arizona Revised Statutes, as added by this act, is effective
18 only on the affirmative vote of at least three-fourths of the members of each
19 house of the legislature.
