**CHAPTER 135**  
**HOUSE BILL 2245**

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 13-1502, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO CRIMINAL  
TRESPASS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 13-1502, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
3 read:

4 13-1502. Criminal trespass in the third degree: classification

5 A. A person commits criminal trespass in the third degree by:

6 1. Knowingly entering or remaining unlawfully on any real property  
7 after a reasonable request to leave by A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER, the owner  
8 or any other person having lawful control over such property, or reasonable  
9 notice prohibiting entry.

10 2. Knowingly entering or remaining unlawfully on the right-of-way for  
11 tracks, or the storage or switching yards or rolling stock of a railroad  
12 company.

13 B. PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION A, PARAGRAPH 1 OF THIS SECTION, A REQUEST TO  
14 LEAVE BY A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER ACTING AT THE REQUEST OF THE OWNER OF THE  
15 PROPERTY OR ANY OTHER PERSON HAVING LAWFUL CONTROL OVER THE PROPERTY HAS THE  
16 SAME LEGAL EFFECT AS A REQUEST MADE BY THE PROPERTY OWNER OR OTHER PERSON  
17 HAVING LAWFUL CONTROL OF THE PROPERTY.

18 ~~B.~~ C. Criminal trespass in the third degree is a class 3 misdemeanor.
