AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 26, CHAPTER 1, ARTICLE 2, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 26-128; RELATING TO THE ARIZONA CITIZENS' MARKSMANSHIP PROGRAM.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:  
2 Section 1. Title 26, chapter 1, article 2, Arizona Revised Statutes,  
3 is amended by adding section 26-128, to read:  
4 26-128. Arizona citizens' marksmanship program; fund;  
5 exemption; program termination  
6 A. THE ARIZONA CITIZENS' MARKSMANSHIP PROGRAM IS ESTABLISHED TO  
7 PROVIDE FIREARMS FOR TRAINING IN MARKSMANSHIP SKILLS TO CITIZENS OF THIS  
8 STATE WHO ARE ELIGIBLE FOR SERVICE IN THE ARIZONA STATE GUARD PURSUANT TO  
9 SECTION 26-121. THE DEPARTMENT OF EMERGENCY AND MILITARY AFFAIRS SHALL  
10 ADMINISTER THE PROGRAM. THE DEPARTMENT MAY:  
11 1. ACCEPT AND SPEND MONIES FROM ANY LAWFUL PUBLIC OR PRIVATE SOURCE,  
12 INCLUDING PRIVATE GRANTS, GIFTS, CONTRIBUTIONS AND DEVICES TO ASSIST IN  
13 CARRYING OUT THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION.  
14 2. IN ACCORDANCE WITH ALL OTHER LAWS, SELL FIREARMS, FIREARM  
15 ACCESSORIES, AMMUNITION AND OTHER EQUIPMENT OR MERCHANDISE TO PROMOTE  
16 MARKSMANSHIP SKILLS.  
17 3. CONTRACT WITH FIREARMS MANUFACTURERS IN THIS STATE TO MANUFACTURE  
18 OR REFURBISH FIREARMS OR FIREARM ACCESSORIES FOR SALE TO PARTICIPANTS IN THE  
19 PROGRAM. FIREARMS THAT ARE MANUFACTURED OR REFURBISHED FOR SALE OR USE IN  
20 THE PROGRAM MUST HAVE THE WORDS "ARIZONA CMP" STAMPED ON THE CENTRAL METALLIC  
21 PART SUCH AS THE RECEIVER OR FRAME IN ADDITION TO THE STAMP REQUIRED BY  
22 SECTION 13-3114.  
23 4. ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS WITH PUBLIC AGENCIES OR PRIVATE ENTITIES TO  
24 ORGANIZE TRAINING COURSES AND EVENTS, INCLUDING YOUTH MARKSMANSHIP AND SAFETY  
25 PROGRAMS.  
26 B. THE ARIZONA CITIZENS' MARKSMANSHIP PROGRAM FUND IS ESTABLISHED  
27 CONSISTING OF PRIVATE GRANTS, GIFTS, CONTRIBUTIONS AND DEVICES AND PROCEEDS  
28 FROM THE SALE OF FIREARMS, FIREARM ACCESSORIES, AMMUNITION AND OTHER  
29 EQUIPMENT OR MERCHANDISE BY THE DEPARTMENT. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADMINISTER  
30 THE FUND. MONIES IN THE FUND ARE CONTINUOUSLY APPROPRIATED AND ARE EXEMPT  
31 FROM THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 35-190 RELATING TO LAPSING OF APPROPRIATIONS.  
32 C. THE PROGRAM ESTABLISHED BY THIS SECTION ENDS ON JULY 1, 2024  
33 PURSUANT TO SECTION 41-3102.
