**AMENDING SECTION 36-2817, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO THE ARIZONA
MEDICAL MARIJUANA ACT.**

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Subject to the requirements of article IV, part 1, section
3 1, Constitution of Arizona, section 36-2817, Arizona Revised Statutes, is
4 amended to read:

5 36-2817. Medical marijuana fund; private donations; drug
6 education and intervention services

7 A. The medical marijuana fund is established consisting of fees
8 collected, civil penalties imposed and private donations received under this
9 chapter. The department shall administer the fund. Monies in the fund are
10 continuously appropriated.

11 B. The director of the department may accept and spend private grants,
12 gifts, donations, contributions and devises to assist in carrying out the
13 provisions of this chapter.

14 C. OF THE MONIES IN THE FUND THAT ARE SPECIFIED IN SUBSECTION A OF
15 THIS SECTION, THE DIRECTOR MAY PROVIDE GRANTS TO LOCAL POLICE DEPARTMENTS TO
16 PROVIDE SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICERS IN HIGH SCHOOLS TO PROVIDE DRUG EDUCATION
17 AND INTERVENTION SERVICES.

18 ~~C.~~ D. Monies in the medical marijuana fund do not revert to the state
19 general fund at the end of a fiscal year.

20 Sec. 2. Requirements for enactment; three-fourths vote

21 Pursuant to article IV, part 1, section 1, Constitution of Arizona,
22 section 36-2817, Arizona Revised Statutes, as amended by this act, is
23 effective only on the affirmative vote of at least three-fourths of the
24 members of each house of the legislature.
