CHAPTER 99
HOUSE BILL 2120

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTIONS 32-503, 32-507, 32-517 AND 32-535, ARIZONA REVISED
STATUTES; RELATING TO THE BOARD OF COSMETOLOGY.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 32-503, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 32-503. Organization; meetings; personnel; compensation

5 A. The board shall annually elect a chairman, vice-chairman and
6 secretary-treasurer from among its membership.

7 B. The board shall hold at least one regular meeting monthly and may
8 hold other meetings at times and places it designates.

9 C. Subject to title 41, chapter 4, article 4, the board may employ the
10 following personnel as it deems necessary to carry out the purposes of this
11 chapter and designate their duties:

12 1. An executive director ~~who shall have been a licensed cosmetologist~~
13 ~~for at least one of the five years immediately preceding employment.~~

14 2. A supervisor of examinations who is an instructor licensed pursuant
15 to this chapter and has worked at least two of the five years immediately
16 preceding employment as an instructor in a school licensed pursuant to this
17 chapter.

18 3. Examiners who ~~shall~~ ARE not ~~be~~ employed as instructors in any
19 school licensed pursuant to this chapter.

20 4. Persons to provide investigative, professional and clerical
21 assistance. ~~as the board deems necessary and may hire~~

22 5. Consultants to assist the board in the performance of its duties.

23 ~~5-~~ 6. Other personnel.

24 D. Members of the board are eligible to receive compensation as
25 determined pursuant to section 38-611 for each day of actual service in the
26 business of the board. The board shall compensate its executive director and
27 other personnel as determined pursuant to section 38-611.

28 Sec. 2. Section 32-507, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

29 32-507. Fees

30 A. The board shall establish and collect fees not to exceed the
31 following:

32 1. Written examination, one hundred dollars.

33 2. Practical examination, one hundred dollars.

34 3. Application for initial personal license, ~~forty-five~~ A ONE-TIME FEE
35 OF EIGHTY-THREE dollars.

36 4. Application for personal reciprocity license, A ONE-TIME FEE OF one
37 hundred ~~twelve~~ FIFTY dollars.

38 5. Application for salon license, one hundred twelve dollars.

39 6. Application for school license, six hundred dollars.

40 7. Application for certification of licensure or hours, thirty
41 dollars.

42 8. Personal license renewal, ~~thirty-eight~~ SEVENTY-SIX dollars TO BE
43 PAID ONCE EVERY TWO YEARS PURSUANT TO SECTION 32-517 OR 32-535.

44 9. Personal license delinquent renewal, sixty dollars.

45 10. Salon license renewal, fifty dollars.

- 1 11. Salon license delinquent renewal, eighty dollars.
2 12. School license renewal, five hundred dollars.
3 13. School license delinquent renewal, six hundred dollars.
4 14. Delinquent penalties for each year or portion of a year for which
5 the license was inactive.
6 15. Computer printouts of names of ~~licenses~~ LICENSEES, twenty-five
7 cents per name.
8 16. Duplicate license, thirty dollars.
9 17. Dishonored checks, twenty dollars.
10 18. Copying charges, one dollar per page. For audiotapes, videotapes,
11 computer discs or other mediums used for recording sounds, images or
12 information, fifteen dollars per tape, disc or other medium.
13 19. Board-administered educational classes, one hundred dollars.
14 20. Review of examination, fifty dollars.
15 21. Regrading of examinations, twenty-five dollars.
16 22. Service charges for persons who pay with alternative payment
17 methods, including credit cards, charge cards, debit cards and electronic
18 transfers, not to exceed the cost of the alternative payment method.
19 B. The board may charge additional fees for:
20 1. Documents and publications provided by the board.
21 2. Services ~~which~~ THAT the board deems appropriate to carry out its
22 intent and purpose. These additional fees shall not exceed the costs of
23 rendering the services.
24 C. The board shall only issue a duplicate license on receipt of a
25 written request ~~which~~ THAT states the reason for the request for a duplicate
26 license.
27 Sec. 3. Section 32-517, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to read:
28 32-517. License renewal
29 A. Except as provided in section 32-4301, a cosmetologist,
30 aesthetician or nail technician shall renew ~~his~~ THE PERSON'S license on or
31 before ~~his~~ THE PERSON'S birth date ONCE every ~~year~~ TWO YEARS.
32 B. A cosmetologist, aesthetician or nail technician shall submit an
33 application for renewal accompanied by the prescribed renewal fee in order to
34 renew ~~his~~ THE PERSON'S license.
35 C. A cosmetologist, aesthetician or nail technician who fails to renew
36 ~~his~~ THE PERSON'S license on or before ~~his~~ THE PERSON'S birth date shall also
37 pay the prescribed delinquent renewal penalty in order to renew ~~his~~ THE
38 license.
39 Sec. 4. Section 32-535, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to read:
40 32-535. Instructor license renewal
41 A. Except as provided in section 32-4301, an instructor shall renew
42 ~~his~~ THE INSTRUCTOR'S license on or before ~~his~~ THE INSTRUCTOR'S birth date
43 ONCE every ~~year~~ TWO YEARS.
44 B. An instructor shall submit an application for renewal accompanied
45 by the prescribed renewal fee in order to renew ~~his~~ THE INSTRUCTOR'S license.

1 C. An instructor who fails to renew ~~his~~ THE INSTRUCTOR'S license on or
2 before ~~his~~ THE INSTRUCTOR'S birth date AS PRESCRIBED BY THIS SECTION shall
3 also pay the prescribed delinquent renewal penalty in order to renew ~~his~~ THE
4 license.
