**CHAPTER 173**  
**HOUSE BILL 2236**

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 28-892, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO MOTORCYCLES  
AND ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 28-892, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
3 read:

4 28-892. Riding on motorcycle or all-terrain vehicle

5 A. A person operating a motorcycle or all-terrain vehicle shall ride  
6 only on the permanent and regular seat attached to the motorcycle or  
7 all-terrain vehicle.

8 B. THE OPERATOR OF A MOTORCYCLE SHALL NOT CARRY ANY OTHER PERSON AND  
9 ANY OTHER PERSON SHALL NOT RIDE ON A MOTORCYCLE UNLESS THE MOTORCYCLE IS  
10 DESIGNED TO CARRY MORE THAN ONE PERSON. ON A MOTORCYCLE DESIGNED TO CARRY  
11 MORE THAN ONE PERSON, A PASSENGER MAY RIDE ON THE PERMANENT AND REGULAR SEAT  
12 IF IT IS DESIGNED FOR TWO PERSONS OR ON ANOTHER SEAT FIRMLY ATTACHED TO THE  
13 MOTORCYCLE AT THE REAR OR SIDE OF THE OPERATOR.

14 C. The operator of ~~a motorcycle or~~ AN all-terrain vehicle shall not  
15 carry any other person and any other person shall not ride on ~~a motorcycle or~~  
16 AN all-terrain vehicle unless the ~~motorcycle or~~ all-terrain vehicle is  
17 ~~designed~~ EQUIPPED to carry more than one person. On ~~a motorcycle or~~ AN  
18 all-terrain vehicle ~~designed~~ THAT IS EQUIPPED to carry more than one person,  
19 a passenger may ride on the permanent and regular seat if it is ~~designed~~  
20 EQUIPPED for two persons or on another seat firmly attached to the ~~motorcycle~~  
21 ~~or~~ all-terrain vehicle at the rear or side of the operator.
