AN ACT

MAKING CAPITAL OUTLAY APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE DIFFERENT DEPARTMENTS OF THE STATE AND FOR STATE INSTITUTIONS.

1 2 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

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Section 1. <u>Capital outlay appropriations: major maintenance and</u>

repair of state buildings: reports

Notwithstanding section 41-793.01, Arizona Revised Statutes. the 4 Α. amounts appropriated in this section are appropriated for fiscal year 5 2016-2017 to be used by the applicable agency for major maintenance and 6 7 repair activities for state buildings in accordance with title 41, chapter 4, 8 article 7, Arizona Revised Statutes. Of the amounts appropriated to the 9 department of administration, up to \$275,000 in personal services and employee-related expenditures for up to five FTE positions may be allocated 10 11 each fiscal year until the building renewal projects are completed. All 12 other monies appropriated in this section may not be spent for personal 13 services or employee-related expenditures or for maintenance contracts on building components and equipment without review by the joint committee on 14 capital review. 15

Before spending the monies 22 23 allocated for this purpose, the department of administration shall submit a 24 report on tenant relocation, including any planned consolidation of state 25 agencies, the current commitment of new tenants and the timeline and 26 estimated costs for relocation for review by the joint committee on capital 27 review.

The department of administration shall allocate \$120,000 of the appropriation in this subsection to repair the 1938 Works Progress Administration civic building on the state fair grounds. The department may not spend the monies allocated for this purpose unless the department receives matching monies from the city of Phoenix to repair the building and this state maintains control and ownership of the building.

34 The department of administration shall allocate the monies to state 35 agencies for necessary building renewal. If monies in the capital outlay stabilization fund established by section 41-792.01, Arizona Revised 36 37 Statutes, are insufficient to fund the appropriation to the department of 38 administration for building renewal, the appropriation to the department of 39 administration is reduced by the difference between the amount appropriated 40 to the department of administration from the capital outlay stabilization 41 fund and the balance in the capital outlay stabilization fund.

42 On or before January 31, 2017 and July 31, 2017, the department of 43 administration shall report to the joint legislative budget committee staff 44 on the status of all building renewal projects and building renewal 45 expenditures.

A. The sum of \$30,000,000 is appropriated from the state general fund in fiscal year 2016-2017 to the department of transportation for Interstate 10 widening projects. These monies shall be combined with funding from the federal fostering advancements in shipping and transportation for the long-term achievement of national efficiencies grant to widen:

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1. Interstate 10 from Earley Road to Interstate 8.

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2. The Interstate 10 interchange with state route 87.

B. Notwithstanding section 41-1252, Arizona Revised Statutes, the appropriation made in subsection A of this section is not subject to review by the joint committee on capital review.

17 C. Notwithstanding any other law or board policy related to the 18 allocation of state highway fund discretionary monies, if the department of 19 transportation does not receive a federal fostering advancements in shipping 20 and transportation for the long-term achievement of national efficiencies 21 grant, the appropriation made in subsection A of this section shall be placed 22 in a subaccount of the state highway fund and used for statewide highway 23 construction as part of the five year transportation facilities construction 24 program established pursuant to section 28-6951, Arizona Revised Statutes.

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Sec. 9. Appropriation: department of transportation: state route 189: exemption from review: alternative use

A. The sum of \$25,000,000 is appropriated from the state general fund in fiscal year 2016-2017 to the department of transportation for the acceleration of the state route 189 construction project from the Mariposa port of entry to Interstate 19.

B. Notwithstanding section 41–1252, Arizona Revised Statutes, the appropriation made in subsection A of this section is not subject to review by the joint committee on capital review.

34 C. Notwithstanding any other law or board policy related to the 35 allocation of state highway fund discretionary monies, if the department of 36 transportation is unable to use the appropriation made in subsection A of 37 this section to accelerate construction of the state route 189 project from 38 fiscal year 2020-2021 to at least fiscal year 2018-2019, or if the department 39 is successful in its application for a \$25,000,000 transportation investment 40 generating economic recovery grant for the state route 189 project, the 41 appropriation made in subsection A of this section shall be placed in a 42 subaccount of the state highway fund and used for statewide highway 43 construction as part of the five year transportation facilities construction 44 program established pursuant to section 28-6951, Arizona Revised Statutes.

14 The amount appropriated for highway construction is from the state 15 highway fund established by section 28-6991, Arizona Revised Statutes, for 16 the planning and construction of state highways, including the national 17 system of interstate highways within this state, the state primary or 18 secondary system, the county primary or secondary system and urban rural 19 routes, the acquisition of rights-of-way, the cost of contracted field 20 administration and field engineering on construction projects and debt 21 service payments on bonds issued for highway construction. Any balances and collections in the state highway fund in excess of the specific amounts 22 23 appropriated in the general appropriation act and in this act are 24 appropriated to the department for the purposes provided in this paragraph.

25 The department of transportation shall report on or before November 1, 26 2016 to the joint committee on capital review on its actual prior year, 27 estimated current year and upcoming budget year highway construction expenses 28 from all fund sources, including appropriated monies, federal monies, local 29 agency monies, state highway monies, bond proceeds and regional area road 30 monies. The report shall be in the same format as in the prior year unless 31 modifications have been approved by the directors of the joint legislative 32 budget committee and the governor's office of strategic planning and 33 budgeting.

On or before November 1, 2016, the department of transportation shall report capital outlay information for fiscal years 2015-2016, 2016-2017 and 2017-2018 to the directors of the joint legislative budget committee and the governor's office of strategic planning and budgeting. This information shall appear in the same format as tables two, three and five, as found in the fiscal year 2015-2016 appropriations report.

0 On or before November 1, 2016, the department of transportation shall report the department's estimated outstanding debt principal balance at the end of fiscal year 2017-2018 and the estimated debt service payment amount for fiscal year 2017-2018 to the directors of the joint legislative budget committee and the governor's office of strategic planning and budgeting. This report shall include state highway fund statewide construction bonds, Arizona highway user revenue fund, Maricopa association of governments and

A. The appropriations made in sections 8, 9, 10 and 11 of this act do not lapse until the purpose for which the respective appropriation was made has been accomplished or abandoned, or the appropriation stands for a full fiscal year without an expenditure or an encumbrance.

Except as provided in subsection A of this section and 6 notwithstanding section 35-190, subsection D, Arizona Revised Statutes, the 7 appropriations made in this act for fiscal year 2016-2017 that are unexpended 8 on June 30, 2018 revert to the fund from which the monies were appropriated. 9 Sec. 16. JCCR review

Pursuant to section 41-1252, Arizona Revised Statutes, the joint committee on capital review shall review the scope, purpose and estimated cost of a new capital project that has an estimated cost of more than \$250,000.
