REQUIRING THE ARIZONA HEALTH CARE COST CONTAINMENT SYSTEM TO REPORT ON THE
AVAILABILITY OF HEALTH RESIDENTIAL FACILITY BEDS FOR SERIOUSLY MENTALLY
ILL ADULTS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. AHCCCS; group home bed availability; report

3 On or before December 1, 2018, the Arizona health care cost
4 containment system shall report to the chairpersons of the senate health
5 and human services committee and the house of representatives health
6 committee the current number of behavioral health residential facility
7 beds and supportive housing beds that are available in this state for
8 adults determined to have a serious mental illness.
