AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 41, CHAPTER 1, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY
ADDING SECTION 41-115; RELATING TO ILLEGAL SUBSTANCE EDUCATION.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 41, chapter 1, article 1, Arizona Revised
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 41-115, to read:

4 ~~41-115.~~ Alcohol, tobacco and drug education: definition

5 A. THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF YOUTH, FAITH AND FAMILY OR THE
6 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES MAY PARTNER WITH STATE AND LOCAL EDUCATION
7 AGENCIES AND FACILITY-BASED NONPROFIT YOUTH DEVELOPMENT ORGANIZATIONS TO
8 ANNUALLY TEACH CHILDREN IN GRADES FIVE THROUGH TWELVE ABOUT THE HEALTH
9 DANGERS OF FEDERALLY DEFINED ILLEGAL SUBSTANCES, TOBACCO, ALCOHOL,
10 MARIJUANA, OPIOIDS AND NONPRESCRIPTION PHARMACEUTICALS.

11 B. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "FACILITY-BASED NONPROFIT
12 YOUTH DEVELOPMENT ORGANIZATION" MEANS AN ORGANIZATION THAT PROVIDES PROVEN
13 AND TESTED RECREATIONAL, EDUCATIONAL AND CHARACTER-BUILDING PROGRAMS FOR
14 CHILDREN WHO ARE AT LEAST SIX AND UNDER NINETEEN YEARS OF AGE.
