A CONCURRENT MEMORIAL

URGING THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS TO ENACT LEGISLATION AMENDING THE
ENDANGERED SPECIES ACT OF 1973.

1 To the Members of the United States Congress:

2 Your memorialist respectfully represents:

3 Whereas, H.R. 2603, the Saving America's Endangered Species Act, or
4 the SAVES Act, has been introduced in the United States House of
5 Representatives; and

6 Whereas, this important legislation would amend the Endangered
7 Species Act of 1973 to provide that nonnative species in the United States
8 not be treated as endangered or threatened species for the purposes of
9 that act.

10 Wherefore your memorialist, the Senate of the State of Arizona, the House
11 of Representatives concurring, prays:

12 1. That the United States Congress enact H.R. 2603, or similar
13 legislation, to amend the Endangered Species Act of 1973.

14 2. That the Secretary of State of the State of Arizona transmit
15 copies of this Memorial to the President of the United States Senate, the
16 Speaker of the United States House of Representatives and each Member of
17 Congress from the State of Arizona.
