AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 13, CHAPTER 23, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 13-2324; RELATING TO UNLAWFUL COMPUTER SOFTWARE USE.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 13, chapter 23, Arizona Revised Statutes, is
3 amended by adding section 13-2324, to read:

4 13-2324. Unlawful computer software use: sales: event ticket
5 purchasing: classification

6 A. A PERSON MAY NOT KNOWINGLY USE OR SELL COMPUTER SOFTWARE THAT IS
7 INTENDED TO CIRCUMVENT A SECURITY MEASURE, ACCESS CONTROL SYSTEM OR OTHER
8 CONTROL MEASURE THAT IS USED BY AN EVENT TICKET PLATFORM TO ENFORCE EVENT
9 TICKET PURCHASING LIMITS OR TO MAINTAIN THE INTEGRITY OF ONLINE TICKET
10 PURCHASING ORDER RULES.

11 B. A PERSON MAY NOT KNOWINGLY SELL OR OFFER TO SELL AN EVENT TICKET
12 THAT WAS OBTAINED BY USING COMPUTER SOFTWARE IN VIOLATION OF SUBSECTION A
13 OF THIS SECTION.

14 C. A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION IS A CLASS 1 MISDEMEANOR.
