**CHAPTER 23**  
**SENATE BILL 1474**

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 38-449, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO FLAG  
DISPLAYS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 38-449, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
3 read:

4 38-449. Display of POW/MIA flag

5 A. The POW/MIA flag shall be displayed on or in front of the  
6 locations prescribed in subsection B OF THIS SECTION on any day when the  
7 United States flag is displayed.

8 B. The locations for the display of the POW/MIA flag pursuant to  
9 subsection A OF THIS SECTION are the following:

10 1. The state capitol building.

11 2. The building that serves as the location of the superior court  
12 in a county.

13 3. The building that serves as the city or town hall of each  
14 incorporated city or town.

15 4. The building that serves as the main administrative building of  
16 each county.

17 C. THE POW/MIA FLAG MAY BE DISPLAYED ON OR IN FRONT OF THE  
18 FOLLOWING LOCATIONS ON ANY DAY WHEN THE UNITED STATES FLAG IS DISPLAYED:

19 1. THE BUILDING THAT SERVES AS THE LOCATION OF THE MUNICIPAL COURT  
20 IN A CITY OR TOWN.

21 2. THE BUILDING THAT SERVES AS THE LOCATION OF THE JUSTICE COURT.

22 3. THE BUILDING THAT SERVES AS THE REGIONAL JUSTICE COURT CENTER.

23 ~~C.~~ D. Notwithstanding any other law, when displayed with the  
24 United States flag on a single staff the POW/MIA flag shall be displayed  
25 below the Arizona state flag. When flags are displayed on multiple staffs  
26 the Arizona flag shall always be displayed to the honor of the United  
27 States flag.
