AMENDING SECTION 33-1307, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO THE
ARIZONA RESIDENTIAL LANDLORD AND TENANT ACT.

5 A. This chapter applies to, regulates, ~~and~~ and determines rights,
6 obligations and remedies under a rental agreement, wherever made, for a
7 dwelling unit located within this state.

8 B. THE REGULATION OF THE RIGHTS, OBLIGATIONS AND REMEDIES OF
9 LANDLORDS AND TENANTS IS A MATTER OF STATEWIDE CONCERN, AND THE REGULATION
10 OF THOSE RIGHTS, OBLIGATIONS AND REMEDIES PURSUANT TO THIS CHAPTER IS NOT
11 SUBJECT TO FURTHER REGULATION BY A COUNTY, CITY, TOWN OR OTHER POLITICAL
12 SUBDIVISION OF THIS STATE.
